

**Forgiving the Unforgivable
You Asked for It

Matthew 6:14-15 (NIV) For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

How do I forgive that which seems unforgivable?

Luke 23:32-33 (NIV) Two other men, both criminals, were also led out with [Jesus] to be executed. When they came to the place called the Skull, they crucified Him there, along with the criminals—one on His right, the other on His left.

Luke 23:34 (NIV) Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

- **Pray for those who hurt you.**

Luke 6:28 (NLT) Bless those who curse you. Pray for those who hurt you.

Matthew 5:43-44 (NIV) You have heard that it was said, "Love your neighbor and hate your enemy." But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.

Our prayers for others may/may not change them, but they will change us.

- **Forgive as you have been forgiven.**

Colossians 3:13 (NIV) ...Forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
